FROM THE DESK OF MR. MORSE

In my last entry I said it was my last one for the 2023-2024 school year, and that is still true. This one pertains to our arrival back in the fall on August 26th, our first day of the 2024-2025 school year! I have three items to share.

First of all, lunch time for the upper grades will see a couple of significant changes. Our microwaves have all given up except for one. That being the case, we are not spending the money to replace them. Students in third through eighth grade will not have microwaves available for heating food. Lunches will need to consist of items not needing heating. Hot water will still be available for items requiring hot water. This change will reduce the volume of trash and create more time for students to eat instead of waiting for a microwave.

Second, we will be more strongly adhering to the dress code. We have allowed it to slip a bit. Please check the RCS website for guidelines.

The third item is cell phones at school. Cell phones need to stay at home. I have an excellent resource produced by a group called AXIS. It is called *A Parent's Guide to SMART PHONE ADDICTION*. I'm sure there are other good resources available, but you are welcome to have a copy of the AXIS article for the asking. Again, see you in the fall!

OTHER IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- **MICROWAYES:** There will be **NO** microwaves in the 2024-2025 school year. Please be sure your child comes with lunch items that do not need to be heated. Hot water will still be available.
- **TARDINESS:** If your student(s) arrive after 8:25am, they will need to come to the school office to receive a tardy slip before going to class.
